This support is available from diagnosis and extends to post-bereavement if a child sadly passes away.

Our dream has always been to build a specialist support centre in Aberdeen that will provide a wide range of services for children with complex disabilities and life-limiting conditions and their families. November 2018 saw the launch of our Big Build Appeal - a three-year fundraising campaign to raise £8million to build this much-needed and life-changing facility. With land secured at Woodend Hospital and our appeal now live, we are on our way to making this dream a reality.
